

FUNGICIDAL WASH

Composition and Application Field

EVI Fungicidal Wash is a highly effective low toxicity bacterial, fungal and algal wash that eliminates paint film spoiling micro-organisms. It is an effective pre-treatment for substrates before commencement of painting to ensure that fungal, algal and mold infestation is properly eliminated.

Application Method

1) New un painted substrates: Apply by roller, brush or spray. Leave material to dry overnight hours to ensure fungal spores are exterminated .Rinse with clean water and dry before application of paint.

2) For previously painted and infested walls, first wash with water and detergent and scrub with a brush to remove existing fungus and molds. Rinse with water and dry before treating with Ritver fungicidal wash as in instruction #1.

Safety Precaution

Avoid contact with the skin and eyes. Wear suitable protective clothing such as overalls, goggles, dust mask and gloves. Use a barrier cream.

Ensure that there is adequate ventilation in the area where the product is being applied. Do not breathe vapour or spray.

FIRST AID
